QUIT CLAIM DEED

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 30th day of October A.D. 1922 between J. T. Bennett, Party of the first part, and V. W. Swoveland, party of the second part.

WITNESSETH, That said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand Six Hundred Fifty and no/100 Dollars to him duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged has quit claimed, granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents does for himself, his heirs, executors and administrators, quit claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns, forever, all his right, title, interest, estate claim and demand both at law and equity in and to all the following described property, to-wit:

Lots Twenty (20) and Twenty-one (21) in Block Six (6) in Abdo Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, according to the recorded plat thereof, together with all the improvements thereon.

(This deed given to correct a Warranty Deed, dated May 3rd, 1918, given by Harry Faurot, a single man, and J. T. Bennett and Cora S. Bennett to V. W. Swoveland, covering the above described property, which deed was signed as J. S. Bennett, when same should have been signed J. T. Bennett.)

Together with all and singular hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above described premises unto the said V. W. Swoveland his heirs and assigns, so that neither he, the said J. T. Bennett, party of the first part or any person in his name and behalf, shall or will hereafter claim or demand any right or title to the said premises or any part thereof; but they and every one of them shall by these presents be excluded and forever barred.
