EXTENSION OF MORTGAGE.

This agreement made this 28th day of December, in the year 1922, by and between Mrs. Edith Mills and W. L. Mills, her husband, parties of the first part and William Vance, party of the second part, witnesseth:

WHEREAS, the said first parties on the 12th day of October, 1920, made and executed and delivered to said second party their note and mortgage of said date to secure the payment of Nine Hundred dollars (\$900) and interest thereon at the rate of ten (10) per cent per annum. Which said mortgage was recorded in the office of the county clerk of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, in book 312 at page 66 of Mortgages. And which said mortgage covered the following described real estate to wit:

Lot Thirteen (13) and fourteen (14) in Block One (1) of Melrose Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma according to the recorded plat thereof.

AND WHEREAS, the said Mrs. Edith Mills and W.L. Mills, of the first part are now yet the owners of the premises described in said mortgage and the said William Vance, of the second part is the owner and holder of the said note and mortgage which by the terms thereof becomes due and payable on the 12th day of October, 1922.

AND WHEREAS, the said first parties desire and request of the said second party that the time of payment of said note and mortgage be extended for a period of one year and in consideration of the agreement upon the part of the said first parties to pay interest on said sum at the rate of ten (10) per cent per annum for said year, and which said agreement the said first parties here by make and undertake and promise to pay the sum of Nine Hundred dollars (\$900) with interest thereon, upon the 12th day of October 1923.

Said William Vance, second party hereby agrees to said extension of time of payment upon condition that all of the rights, privileges liens and incumbrances provided and set out in the original mortgage hereinbefore referred to be extended and continued in force during the period of extension of this mortgage and that none of the terms, conditions or provisions shall be altered or changed in any respect or particular except, that the time of payment of principal and interest is extended to the 12th day of October, 1923.

And in consideration of said extension the said first parties agree and both parties agree and consent in all respects and particulars to the conditions and provisions of this instrument.
