All vote "AYE". Motion prevailed.

Whereas, payment in full having been made on said note.

Now, therefore, under and by virtue of the above resolution, the Commissioners of the Land Office, by their Chairman and Secretary for and on behalf of the State of Oklahoma, in consideration of value received, do hereby acknowledge full payment and complete satisfaction of the mortgage above described, and do hereby release and discharge said land from the lien of said mortgage.
