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SHERIFF'S DEED.

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Know all men by these presents: That whereas, on the 14th day of June, 1921, in the District Court within and for Yulsa County, State of Oklahoma, in a certain action therein pending wherein Katie B. Lile was plaintiff and 4. W. Mitchener and First National Bank of Roff, Oklahoma, a corpora tion, were defendents, being No.7082, which said cause was consolidated with cause No. 8914 in which Claude Sample was plaintiff and Katie B. Lile, T. W. Mitchener, First Mational Bank of Roff, Oklahoma D. G. Elliott, D. G. Elliott, Trustee, J. E. Burr, Paul C. Hughes, and F. P. McCormick were defendents, with which case there was also consolidated case No.7985, in which F. P. McCormick was plaintiff, Katie B. Lile, Claude Sample, T. W. Mitchener William Vance, Guardian of Benjamin Vance, a minor, First National Bank of Roff, Okla, homa, a corporation, D. G. Elliott, and the city of Tulsa, a municipal corporation, were defendants, and judgement was rendered wherein it was adjudged that F.P. McCormick have and recover the sum of One Hundred and Soventy Three & 09/100 (\$173.09) dollars and \$50.00 attorney fees upon his first cause of action, and the sum of Three hundred sixty three & 57/100 (\$363.57) dollars, and \$50.00 attorney fees upon his second cause of action, and costs, with interest at seven per cent, per amum, from June 14, 1921, and further decreeing a lien in favor of the said F. P. McCormick, foreclosing the same upon the south fifty (50) feet of lot one (1) in Block nineteen (19) of North Yulsa addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, in Tulsa County Oklahoma, and wherein it was further adjudged that William Vance Guardian of Benjamin Vance, a minor, have and recover judgement against T. E. Mitchener, in the sum of One thousand, one hundred seventy eight &88/100 (\$1178.88) with the further sum of \$126.38 as attorney fees, totaling the sum of Thirteen Hundred five & 26/100 (\$1305.26) dollars, with interest therein at eight per cent, per annum from June 14, 1921.

And it is further decreed that said William Vance have a lien, and that same be foreclosed upon the above described property. Same being the southerly half (1) of lot one (1) in Block nineteen (19) in North Tulsa, Same being an addition to the City of Tulsa, Okla.

It was further ordered and adjudged that Claude Sample have judgement against T. W.
