Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Mayor and Board of Commissioners, of the City of Tulsa, Section 1, that it is the expressed intent of the Mayor and Board of Commissioners that no reservation was made into the City of Tulsa in Ordinance No. 2331, vacating said above described premises as a public street, to reopen said premises as an alley at any time in the future without the consent of the owners of the property contiguous to said described premises to whom the title reverted by said ordinance of vacation or without resorting to condemnation proceedings as provided by law.

Wherefore, be it resolved that an emergency exists for the preservation of the public health and safety by reason whereof this resolution shall take effect from and after its passage and approval.
