Witnesseth, that the said parties of the first part, in consideration, of the debt and trust hereinafter mentioned and created and the sum of One Dollar to them paid by the party of the second part, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by their presents grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm, unto the said party of the second part, the following described real estate, situated in the county of Tulsa, and State of Oklahoma,

Lot eighteen (18) Block one (1) Rayburn's sub-division of lot 3 section 9, township 19, north, range 12 east, in Tulsa County, (an addition to the City of Tulsa) according to the recorded plat thereof,

and Certificate number 807, being for five shares of "D" stock in the Central Savings and Loan Association, of Marshall, Missouri, and possession of said premises and said shares of stock are now delivered unto the said party of the second part.

To have and to hold, the same with all the rights and appurtenances thereto belonging to the said party of the second part and to his successor hereinafter designated, and to the assigns of him and his successor, forever.
