Hubert ^{Bryles} ~~Bryles~~, her husband and wife of Tulsa Oklahoma, made, executed, and delivered to The Commissioners of the Land Office of the State of Oklahoma, for the use and benefit of the State of Oklahoma, one certain ^{note for} the sum of Twenty five hundred and no/100 (\$2500.00) dollars, secured by a real estate mortgage on all of the following described property situated in Tulsa County, to-wit:

The NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 34, township 18 North, range 14 east of the Indian Base and Meridian, containing 160 acres, according to the United States survey thereof.
