Witnesseth: That for and in consideration of the rents, covenants, and agreements hereinafter provided, on the part of the lessee to be paid and performed, the lessor doth hereby let and lease unto the said lessee for grazing and hay-cutting purposes only, the following described tract of land lying and being within the limits of the Cherokee Nation, and within the county of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, to-wit: NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec. 16, twp. 22, range 13, containing 40 acres, more or less, for the period beginning on the 1 day of Jan. 1923, fully to be completed and ended on the 31 day of Dec. 1928, subject to the conditions hereinafter provided for.

The said lessee in consideration of said premises, as above set forth, covenant and agree with the lessor to pay said lessor as rental for the same, the sum of one hundred twenty dollars (\$120.00) being at the rate of 50/100 dollars (\$.50) per acre per annum, payable as follows, to-wit: \$20.00 cash in advance as rental for year 1923, when this lease is approved, and \$20.00 to be paid on first day of July of each succeeding year thereafter during term of this lease.

The covenants and agreements hereinbefore mentioned shall extend to and be binding upon the heirs, assigns, executors and administrators of the parties to this lease.
