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POWER OF ATTORNEY* COMPARED

Know all men by these presents: That I, T. K. Smith of the City of Tulsa, Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, have made, constituted and appointed and by these presents do make, constitute and appoint A. D. Blackard of the city of Tulsa, Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, my true and lawful attorney, for me and in my name, place and stead and as my act and deed, to deposit any moneys received for me by said attorney in my name, in the Liberty National Bank of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and to draw checks in my name against said moneys, and any other moneys there deposited in my name or to my credit, and to draw checks in my name on any bank in which I have moneys on deposit or money deposited in my name or to my credit in said banks. To endorse, discount, sell, assign and negotiate upon such terms as he may deem best, all checks, drafts, notes, bills of exchange, trade and banker's acceptances and other negotiable or non-negotiable paper payable to me or to my order, and to accept and pay any check, trade acceptance or bill of exchange drawn upon me in relation to such matters. To collect and receive any and all sums of money due me and to incur and pay all reasonable expenses incident to the collections of any amounts due me from any firm, person or corporation. To execute and deliver receipts and other necessary or proper instruments necessary in the making of collections of money due me, and generally to do all such things in connection therewith as may be necessary and proper in the premises. To grant, bargain, sell, contract lease, exchange, give options, or manage, operate, convey and dispose of in such manner and upon such consideration and terms as said attorney may deem advisable, the real estate owned by me which is located within the State of Oklahoma, or other states and territories of the United States. To collect, receive and sue for all rents, royalties and other considerations or payments derived or to be derived from any and all real estate or property owned by me, whether said property is owned by me alone or jointly with others. To execute, acknowledge and deliver deeds, conveyances, assignments, options, leases, contracts and all other instruments necessary or proper in connection therewith. To vote at the meetings of any corporations all shares of stock I now have or may hereafter own or be entitled to vote thereat; to exercise any and all other rights I may have as such stockholder, and to sign, seal and deliver to himself any proxies or other instruments he may deem expedient. To collect and receive from any corporations in which I now or may hereafter own stock, all dividends due me from such corporations, and to deposit the amounts so received as dividends to my credit in the Liberty National Bank of Tulsa, Oklahoma. Giving and granting unto my said attorney, full power and authority to do and perform all and every act and thing whatsoever requisite and necessary to be done in and about the premises, as fully to all intents and purposes as I might or could do if personally present at the doing thereof, hereby ratifying and confirming for myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, all that my attorney shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue thereof.
