Whereas, the said lease and all rights thereunder or incident thereto, and said easement and all rights thereunder or incident thereto, are now named by Fred W. Insull.

Now, therefore, for and in consideration of One Dollar and other good and valuable considerations, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the undersigned, the present owner of the said lease and of the said easement, and all rights thereunder or incident thereto, does hereby bargain, sell, transfer, assign, and convey unto the Tulsa County Coal Company, its heirs, successors and assigns, forever, all of the right, title and interest of the said Fred W. Insull, the present owner of the said lease and easement, and all rights thereunder insofar as it covers all of the property above described, together with all personal property used or obtained in connection therewith.
