RELEASE OF OIL AND GAS LEASE.

Whereas, a certain oil, and ^{gas} mining lease, dated the 25th day of November, 1922, given to W. P. Root and Stella M. Root, his wife, lessors to L. H. McClung, J. F. Murphy, C. C. Peters and A. C. Stiles, lessees, and covering the following described lands to-wit: The south half of the southeast quarter of section 34, township 19 north, range 10 east, and the southwest quarter of section 35, township 19 North, range 10 east, containing 240 acres more or less, in section 34 & 35, twp. 19 North, range 10 east, county of Tulsa, all in the State of Oklahoma, and recorded on the 20th day of December, 1913, in book 162, at page 695, of the records of the said county, and

Whereas, by virtue of an assignment of said oil and gas mining lease, as above described, the same is now owned by The Paris Company, insofar as it covers the north half of the southwest quarter and the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter, of section 35, township 19, range 10 east in Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

Now, therefore, know all men by these presents: That the said The Paris Company, a corporation, does hereby cancel, release, relinquish and surrender all of its right, title and interest in and to the said Oil and Gas Mining Lease insofar as it covers the lands last above described.
