LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT OF ALEXANDER MCGEACHIE.

Know all men by these presents: That I, Alexander McGeachie, being of sound mind and memory, do make, and public, and declare this instrument, to be my last will and testament, in words and figures, following to wit hereby revoking any and all former wills, if any have been made.

1st----- I give, devise and bequeath unto my son, William McGeachie, all my real and personal estate of whatever nature and kind and wheresoever situated, subject only, to the following bequests and directions:

First:--- I direct all my just debts and funeral expenses first be paid.

Second:- -To my grandson John McGeachie, the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars (\$150.00)

To my granddaughter Belle McGeachie, the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars (\$150.00).

To my Grandson Harry McGeachie, the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars, (\$150.00)

To my grandson Randall McGeachie, the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars, (\$150.00).

To my Grandson Robert B. McGeachie, the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars (\$150.00).

To my granddaughter, Blanche McGeachie, the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars (\$150.00).

In case of the death of any of my said Grandchildren, I direct that their shares be divided equally with the survivors of the two sets of grand children as above named and specified.

I hereby appoint my said son William S. McGeachie, my executor without bond, of this my last will and testament; and in case of his death, then his son Alexander McGeachie, Jr. to act in his stead.
