

Now, according to the provisions of section 1573 (as amended by Act of Congress approved August 22, 1912) of the Revised Statutes, if within four months from this date Frank W. Colburn shall present this, his honorable Discharge, at any United States Naval Rendezvous, and if found physically qualified, and shall reenlist for four years, then he shall be entitled to pay during the said four months equal to that to which he would have been entitled had he been employed in actual service.

Upon re-enlistment, on the surrender of this Discharge, should he so desire, he will receive a continuous service certificate, showing his service and honorable discharge, and shall receive an addition of one dollar and thirty six cents per month to the pay of the rating in which he enlists or to which he may be promoted.
