ORDINANCE #2355.

Ordinance No. 2355. An ordinance vacating a portion of eighteenth (18th) Street,
particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the southwest corner of Lot 5, Block 3, Woodward Park Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, according to the recorded plat thereof, running thence in a southerly direction, and on the projection of the west line of said lot 5, Block 3, in said addition to the northwest, corner of lot 1, Block 4, of said addition; running thence east along the north line of said lot 1, Block 4, said addition, and on a projection of said line toward the east to a point where the projection of said line intersects with the northerly projection of the east line of said lot 1, Block 4, of said addition; running thence north along the northerly projection of the east line of said lot 1, Block 4, in said addition to a point where the said projection intersects the easterly projection of the south line of lot 5, Block 3, in said addition, running thence in a westerly direction along the south line of lot 5, Block 3, in said addition to the place of beginning, Woodward Park Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, with certain reservations, and declaring an emergency.

Whereas, a petition signed by all of the property owners owning property abutting on the strip of ground commonly known as eighteenth street, in the addition herein mentioned, has been presented to the Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, asking that a portion of the strip of ground commonly known as Eighteenth Street, therein described, be vacated and abandoned as a public street.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF TULSA, OKLAHOMA:

Section 1, That a portion of Eighteenth Street, more particularly described above and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned as a public street of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma,

Provided, however that the City of Tulsa, hereby reserves and shall retain forever, the right to construct, reconstruct, repair, maintain and operate sanitary sewers, and other appurtenances thereto appertaining, now located in said strip of ground, commonly known as Eighteenth Street, of which of necessity should be constructed or maintained in said strip of ground, commonly known as Eighteenth Street, with the right to ingress and egress over said premises for the purposes above indicated and for said purposes four (4) feet from each side of the center line of said strip of ground commonly known as eighteenth Street, is hereby maintained by the City of Tulsa upon which said City of Tulsa may allow public service corporations, companies, individuals or itself, to construct, maintain and operate facilities for public utilities, including poles, wires, pipes conduits, and other necessary accessories; and

Provided, further, that four (4) feet on each side of the center line of said strip of ground, commonly known as Eighteenth Street, shall be constructed to mean sufficient space near the center of said strip of ground, commonly known as Eighteenth Street, for the purposes above specified.

And provided further, that the above vacation is made subject to the conditions and provisions of paragraph 11 of section 6, of article 11 of the Charter of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma.

Section 2, That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance in so far as such conflict exists, are hereby repealed.
