W. Coleman, parties of the first part, the following described real property and premises, situate in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

West ten acres (10) of lot one (1) of section
 fourteen(14) township nineteen (19) north,
 Range twelve (12) east of the Indian Base and
 Meridian - containing 10 acres, more or less,
 located in Tulsa County, Oklahoma

together with all the improvements thereon and the appurtenances thereunto belonging, and warrant the title to the same, subject to any valid leases on the land described herein.

To have and to hold said described premises unto the said part^{ies} the second part their heirs and assigns forever free, clear and discharged of and from all former grants, charges, taxes, judgements, mortgages, and other liens and encumbrances of whatever nature.
