ORDER APPROVING DEED.

Now, in this 16th day of December, 1922, there coming on for hearing the petition of Eli E. Hardridge, a full blood member and citizen of the Creek Tribe of Indians, enrolled opposite No. 3507, praying the approval of his deed to R. C. Allen, conveying an undivided one-eighth interest in the allotment of Helen Hardridge, deceased, described as follows to-wit:

The north half of the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter and the northeast quarter of the northwest quarter, and the north half of the north half of the south half of the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter, and lot 2, all in section 12, township 18 north, range 12 east and the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter of section 32, township 18, north, range 13 east, all in Tulsa County, Oklahoma,

and it appearing that said deed was executed on September 5, 1922, for a valuable consideration, that said Helen Hardridge, at the time of her death, resided in Okmulgee County, Oklahoma, that said land was a part of her allotment, as a member and citizen of the Creek Nation, and there being no objection offered to the approval of said deed, and the court being fully advised in the premises, finds; that the allegations contained in said petition are true and that this court has full and complete jurisdiction in the premises.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed that the said deed executed as aforesaid on the 5th day of September, 1922, by said petitioner to the said R. C. Allen be and the same is hereby approved by accordance with the provisions of the act of Congress, approved May 7th, 1908.
