All in Carbondale.

Provided, however, it is expressly understood and agreed that this release and quit claim shall not be construed as releasing any portion of the real estate as herein ^{above} first described other than these lots in Carbondale as herein set forth and described.

MORTGAGE DEED.

This indenture, made this 15th day of January, A.D. 1923, between Gline Hamison and Stella Harrison, his wife of Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first
