CONTRACT.

This agreement, made and entered into this 14 day of June, 1921, by and between George Hazlett, party of the first part and W. A. Robbins, party of the second part, WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the party of the first part has discovered and secured a patent on a superheater, under patent No. 469426, to be used in connection with refining ^{crude} oil, the purpose of which is to increase the yield of refined products from crude oil with no extra over-head charges for operation or expenses for fuel.

WHEREAS, the party of the first part does not desire to sell said patent outright, but desired to have said process and equipment installed in refineries on a royalty basis.

WHEREAS, the party of the first part desired to have the party of the second part act as his sole agent in locating refineries and operators of refineries, to install said patent process on a royalty basis.

NOW, THEREFORE, FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of one dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable consideration and the covenants and agreements hereinafter set out, it is agreed between the parties hereto that the party of the second part is to be and act as the sole agent and representative of the party of the first part in inducing operators of refineries to install said patent process and operate the same in connection with their refineries.

IT IS FURTHER UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED between the parties hereto, that the party of the second part is to receive directly from the operators of refineries where said patent process is installed, one half of the royalties which accrue from the operation of said patent process, and which are agreed to be paid by the operators of any and all refineries using said patent process.

IT IS FURTHER UNDERSTOOD AND AGREED, between the parties hereto, that the party of the second part is to receive one-half of all royalties, profits and sales of said patent process.

IT IS UNDERSTOOD between the parties hereto, that this agreement shall extend to and be binding upon the heirs, successors and assigns of the party of the first part.
