Witnesseth: That said party of the first part in consideration of one thousand dollars (\$1000.00) the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does, by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, the following described real estate, situated in Tulsa County, and State of Oklahoma, to wit:

Lots twenty seven (27) twenty eight (28) twenty nine (29) and thirty (30) in Block eight (8) in Parkdale addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, according to the duly recorded plat thereof.

To have and to hold the same, unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining, forever,
