

In Tulsa County, Oklahoma;

that on the 12th day of July, 1916, he executed, acknowledged and delivered to Sallie Morrison, of Tulsa County, a Trust Deed, conveying all of his allotment of land above described to her, in order that she might look after the same in way of leasing and renting and keeping up the place for him during his absence in the military service; that the purpose of said Trust Deed have long since been fulfilled, and carried out, and that he has caused to be prepared a quit claim deed and presented the same to Sallie Morrison and demanded that she execute and deliver the same to him, removing the cloud from his title to said land created by the Trust Deed above referred to, but that she has declined to do so, that he has on this day, January 19, 1923, filed a suit in the District Court of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, wherein he is plaintiff and Sallie Morrison is the defendant, in which he seeks a judgement of said court, canceling, setting aside and holding for naught said Trust Deed and quieting his title to said above described land against the same.

Affiant now gives notice to the public that said Trust Deed, executed, acknowledged and delivered by him to Sallie Morrison, on July 12th, 1916, covering the Southeast (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) quarter of section thirty three (33) township nineteen (19) N, north, range eleven (11) east, Tulsa County, Oklahoma,

is hereby annulled and revoked and that he has resumed the control of his said land herein described and that Sallie Morrison has no right or authority to act for him in the management of control of the same in any way or manner.
