AGREEMENT FOR EXTENSION OF MORTGAGE DEBT AND LIEN.

This agreement made and entered into this 15th day of January, 1923, by and between
M. W. Pate and Jennie W. Pate, his wife, parties of the first part, and H. Clopath,
party of the second part, witnesseth:

Whereas, a certain mortgage was made and executed and delivered on the 15th day of

Rupp, to L. N. Ewing, to secure a note in the sum of \$1500.00 with interest at 8 per
cent per annum, payable semi-annually and covering

and, Whereas, the property above described, covered by said mortgage is now owned

Now, therefore, in consideration of these premises and of other good and valuable
considerations, it is hereby agreed between the parties hereto that the time of payment
