This indenture made and entered into as of the fifteen th day of December, 1922,
by and between Wm. M. Thompson and Lelah Thompson, his wife; J. N. Thompson and Wilma
Thompson, his wife; and Robert H. Hughes, a single man, residents of the City of
Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, parties of the first part, sometimes herein called first
parties, and the St. Louis Union Trust Company, a corporation organized and existing
under the laws of the State of Missouri, with its principal office in the City of
St. Louis, in said State party of the second part, sometimes called the Trustee:

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, said first parties are now the owners of the property hereinafter
described and desire to borrow money, and to that end desire to issue and negotiate
