CONTRACT.

 Know all men by these presents: That this contract made and entered into this 25th day of January, 1923, by and between Mr. J. B. McAnally and Mr. O. Kubatsky, as owners of the Alhambra Theatre, situated in the City of Tulsa, County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, as parties of the first part, and Edward Chouteau Legge, hereafter known as party of the second part, witnesseth:

That for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements to be kept and performed by the parties hereto, which are hereafter more fully mentioned and set out. The parties of the first part have this day employed the said Edward Chouteau Legge for a period of three (3) years from the first day of April, 1923, or as soon thereafter as the Alhambra Theatre shall be completed and ready for business, and the consideration of this contract is as follows:

The parties of the first part hereby agree to and with the said party of the second part, that upon the organization of a certain stock company, which the parties of the first <sup>part</sup> have agreed to and will organize for the Capital Stock of Fifty Thousand (\$50,000.00) dollars, the said parties of the first part hereby agree to assign and deliver with the proper certificate of attestation, one thousand (1000) shares of stock in the said company, par value five (\$5.00) dollars per share, to the party of the second, and the parties of the first part hereby also agree to pay the party of the second part, the sum of eighty dollars <sup>(\$80.00)</sup> per week, payable at the end of each and every week.

The said party of the second part is to play one certain W. W. Kimball Company Pipe Organ, situated in and being part of the Alhambra Theatre, during the term and continuation of this contract.

The parties of the first part hereby agree to allow the party of the second part, a period of two weeks and not more than one calendar month each year as a vacation, and that the party of the second part will be allowed to place a substitute in his place.

It is expressly understood and agreed between all parties of this contract, that at the expiration of three (3) years from April 1st, 1923, or as soon thereafter as the Alhambra Theatre may be completed and ready for business, that this contract shall be ended.

It is further understood between all parties hereto that this contract is drawn in triplicate, and in any event either copy may be treated and used as the original thereof.
