ORDER FOR REMOVAL OF RESTRICTIONS

Whereas, Susanna Hatkey, now Holmes, a citizen of the Creek Nation was allotted the following described land, to-wit:

Northwest quarter (NW4) of the southeast quarter (SE4)
of section thirty two (32) township eighteen (18) north,
Range fourteen (14) east of the Indian Base and Meridian
containing forty (40) acres, more or less located in
Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

Now, therefore I under the authority vested in me by the Act of Congress approved May 27 1908 (Public No. 140) and the regulations prescribed thereunder, hereby remove the restrictions from said above described land without conditions concerning terms of sale and disposal of the proceeds, said removal of restrictions to be effective thirty days from date hereof.
