This indenture of lease, made and entered into in quadruplicate on this 5th day of Oct, A.D. 1922, by and between Edward Longbird, Bunch, Okla. enrolled as a citizen of the Cherokee Nation, Roll No. 28897, party of the first part, hereinafter designated as lessor, and Gid Graham, of Nowata, Okla., party of the second part, hereinafter designated as lessee, under and in pursuance of the provisions of the Act of Congress approved May 27, 1908, (35 Stat. I.P. 312);

Witnesseth, that for and in consideration of the rents covenants, and agreements hereinafter provided, on the part of the lessee, to be paid and performed, the lessor doth hereby let and lease unto the said lessee for grazing and hay-cutting purposes only, the following described tract of land lying and being within the limits of the Cherokee Nation, and within and county of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma,
