## ASSIGNMENT OF OIL AND GAS

## MINING LEASE

WHEREAS, on the 6th day of January, A. D. 1914, a certain Oil and Gas Mining Lease was made and entered into by and between Jennie Turk, Administratrix of the Estate of Noah G. Turk, deceased,

Lessor, and J. E. Stingley,

Lessee, said lease being recorded in the Office of the County Clerk in and for Tulsa County, Oklahoma, in Book 165, at page 47, covering the following described land in said County of Tulsa, and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

An undivided One-half interest in and to the North half (1/2) of the Southwest Quarter (1/4) of the Northeast Quarter (1/4) of Section Thirty-one (31), in Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Twelve (12) East of the Indian Base and Meridian, containing twenty (20) acres, more or less, and,

WHEREAS, said lease was thereafter duly assigned to F. A. Gillespie on the 10th day of January, A. D. 1914;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of One Dollar, and other good and valuable considerations, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the undersigned, the present owner of said lease and all right thereunder, or incident thereto, does hereby bargain, sell, transfer, assign, set over and convey unto F. A. GILLESPIE AND SONS COMPANY all of his right, title and interest therein and thereto, hereby covenanting, for himself, his heirs, assigns and legal representatives, with said Assignee, its successors, and assigns, that he is the lawful owner of said lease and rights thereunder, and of the personal property thereon, or used in connection therewith; that he has good right and authority to sell and convey the same, and that said rights, interest and property are free and clear from all liens and encumbrances;
