The first payment of \$205. is to be paid July 15, 1917, and \$205. each six mos. thereafter during her life. And to guarantee to her these payments of \$205. every six mos. E. Pleas has left in her hands thirty shares of stock in the First Natl. Bank of Tulsa Okla. Cer. No. 398, Valued at Seven Thousand Dollars and it is so written on the certificate that is is held by Mary J. E. Wilson to protect her in her rights in this contract. And for this obligation that E. Pleas takes upon himself he received of Mary E. Wilson one Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged.
