

covering the note sued upon, together with interest at 10% thereon from July 24th, 1921, and 10% upon the principal and interest as attorney's fee, it is ordered that plaintiff have its judgment as prayed for.

It is, therefore, ordered, adjudged and decreed that the plaintiff, Southwest National Bank of Dallas, do have and recover of and from the said defendant, J. W. Gilliland, the sum of \$187,758.33 which said sum includes principal of \$150,000.00 interest to this date as specified in said notes in the principal sum of \$20416.67, and 10% upon the principal and interest as specified in said notes in the sum of \$17041.66 as attorney's fees.

It is further ordered, adjudged, and decreed that said judgment bear interest at the rate of 10% per annum from this date, and the costs of this suit, for the collection of which said sum and costs, execution is hereby awarded.
