#### ASSIGNMENT

dated January 13, 1923

FOR VALUE RECEIVED, I, C. M. Bowyer do hereby sell, transfer and assign unto Robt. E. Adams all my right, title and interest, except as hereinafter stated, in and to a certain real estate mortgage dated May 12, 1922 executed by Mrs. L. E. Frank, Mortgagor to C. M. Bowyer for the sum of \$2919.20 covering all of Lots Seventeen (17) and Eighteen (18) in Block One (1) of Bullette Addition to the City of Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, according to the recorded plat thereof, said mortgage being recorded in Book 358, page 325 of the records of Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

This assignment is made for the purpose of securing to said assignee sixteen written promissory notes of a series of notes described and secured by said mortgage, said notes being described as follows:

The first note matures on the 12th day of February 1923 and one each thirty days thereafter for 16 months, each note being for the sum of \$25.00, which said notes have this date been sold to Robt. E. Adams, said assignee.

Said C. M. Bowyer by this assignment does hereby agree that in case it is necessary to institute foreclosure proceedings to collect the notes sold that said Robt. E. Adams shall have a priority in the security described in said mortgage and shall have the right to have the proceeds of any foreclosure sale applied first on payment of notes herein described.

Said assignor hereby reserves right to foreclose subject to right of this assignee in case of default of notes assigned by him.
