

Provided, further, that the above vacation is made subject to the conditions and provisions of paragraph 11 of Section 6 of Article 11 of the charter of the City of Tulsa.

SECTION 2. That the provisions of all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be, and the same are hereby repealed insofar as such conflict exists.

SECTION 3. That an emergency exists for the preservation of the public welfare and safety, by reason whereof this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.

PASSED, and the emergency clause ruled upon separately and approved this 26th day of March, 1920.
