CENERAL WARRANT DEED

INTERNAL REVENUE

THAT, In consideration of the sum of One Pollar and other valuable considerations the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, said party of the first part does, by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the county of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot One (1) in Block two (2), EDGWOOD PLACE ADDITION to the city of Tulsa, Oklahoma, according to the recorded plat thereof.

TO HAVE TO HOLD THE SEME, Together with all and singular the tenements, heredital ments and appurtenences thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining forever.

The said John H. Miller, on his behalf as Trustee, and on behalf of the following persons, A. Gianakos and Moto Gianakos, his wife, of Pittsburg, Pa., Peter G. Caravasios and Marika Caravasios, his wife, of Wheeling, West Virginia, and James G. This conveyance is given subject to the following conditions and restrictions, perpetual if not otherwise specified; That no residence shall be erected thereon costing less than \$3500.00, inclusive of subsidiary buildings and improvements on such lot; that no buildings or any part thereof, except steps or entrance approach without roof, shall be built or extended within twenty-five (25) feet from the front lot line; or within ten (10) feet from a side street line; that the lot or lots hereby conveyed shall not within a period of ten (10) years from this date be used for any other residence purposes; that only one residence shall be built on one lot; provided, however, that on carner lots more than one residence may be erected if consent thereto is inserted in the conveyance of such lots; that no part of the lot or lots hereby conveyed shall ever be sold or rented to or occupied by any persons of African descent,
