WHEREAS, on November 4, 1921, R. E. Lynch was the owner of an undivided one-half interest in and to the oil, gas, coal and other mineral rights in, to and on the following described premises situate in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The Northwest Quarter of Section 25, Township 19 North, Range 10 East, containing 160 acres, more or less.

and

WHEREAS on that date he did convey to John F. Hayden an undivided one-half interest of his undivided one-half interest in and to the entire oil, gas, coal and other mineral rights, and

WHEREAS, through inadvertence and mistake in one paragraph of said conveyance language is used which might be construed to mean that said conveyance was of one-fourth of said undivided one-half interest, or merely of one-eighth of the entire oil, gas, coal and other mineral rights; and

WHEREAS, such a construction would be in conflict with the intention and contract of the parties and with the remainder of the instrument,

NOW, THEREFORE, said R. E. Lynch, in order to clear up said ambiguity in said conveyance of said oil, gas, coal and other mineral rights of November 4, 1921, does hereby, for and in consideration of the consideration for said grant of November 4, 1921, and in consideration of the further sum of \$1.00 to him in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, stipulate and agree with said John F. Hayden, his heirs, administrators, executors and assigns, that the true construction of said grant of November 4, 1921, and the true intention thereof is to convey to said John F. Hayden, the grantee therein, an undivided one-fourth interest in and to the entire oil, gas, coal and other mineral rights in, to or on said premises hereinbefore described.

This stipulation is binding upon my heirs, administrators, executors and assigns.
