WITNESSETH, That said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Eleven Thousand Dollars the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns all the following described real Estate, situate in Tulsa County, and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:
