The lessee hereby agrees to pay or cause to be paid to the Superintendent of the Five Civilized Tribes, Muskogee, Oklahoma, for the lessor, as royalty, the sum of 122 per cent. of the gross proceeds of all crude oil extracted from the said land, such payment to re made at the time of sale or removal of the oil. And the lessee shall pay as royalty on each gas producing well three hundred dollars per annum in advance, to be calculated from the date of commencement of utilization: PROVIDED, however, in the case of gas wells of small volume, (RCYALTY No.48107) when the rock pressure is one hundred pounds or less, the parties hereto may, subject to the

gas as fuel so far as necessary to the development and operation of said property.

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
