ASSIGNMENT OF OIL AND GAS LEASE.

WHEREAS, The Secretary of the Interior has heretofore approved an oil and gas mining lease, dated the 1st day of April 1920, entered into by and between Buck Grayson, lessor, and M. A. De Vinna, lessee, covering the following described lands in the Creek Nation, Oklahoma:

The Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) and the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 5, Township 19 N., Range 12 E., of the Indian Meridian, and containing 80 acres, more or less.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of One and no/100 (\$1.00) dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said M. A. De Vinna, the lessee in the above-described lease, hereby bargains, sells, transfers, assigns, and conveys all of his right, title, and interest of the lessee in and to said lease, insofar as it contains to the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 5, Twp. 19 N., Rge. 12 E., and containing 70 acres more or less, subject to the approval of the Secretary of the Interior to Echo Oil Company of Tulsa, Oklahoma. Said assignment to be effective from date of approval hereof by the Secretary of the Interior.
