QUIT CLAIM DEED

WITNESSETH, That said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of one dollar and other good and valuable considerations DOLLARS to him duly paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged he has quit claimed, granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents does for himself his heirs, executors and administrators, quit claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said parties of the second part and to their heirs and assigns, forever, all his right, title, interest, estate -----claim and demand both at law and equity in and to all the following described property, to-wit:

Lots four (4) and five (5) in Block Sixty-one (61) in the original town, now city of Tulsa according to the recorded plat thereof, with all improvements thereon, which property is not now and never has been the homestead of said party of the first part.

Together with all and singular hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above described premises unto the said parties of the second part their heirs and assigns, so that neither the said Orra E. Upp or any person in his name and behalf, shall or will hereafter claim or demand any right or title to the said premises or any part thereof; but they and every one of them shall by these presents be excluded and forever barred.
