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the same become due, and to keep the buildings upon the mortgaged premises insured in some reliable fire insurance company, approved by the party of the second part, for the sum of Four Thousand (4000) Dollars, and to assign the policies to said party of the second part, to be held by her until this mortgage is fully paid and said parties of the first part assume all responsibility of proof and care and expense of collecting such insurance if loss occurs.

SEVENTH. It is further agreed by and between the parties hereto that should drilling be commenced upon said premises at any time for oil or gas, or mining operations be commenced upon said premises, whether by shaft mining, stripping or any other process for the purpose of removing from said land any coal, minerals, stone or other substances of any character whatsoever, such drilling or mining shall operate to make the debt which this mortgage secures, payable upon demand, and second party hereto shall be entitled to demand and receive from the first parties full payment of said mortgage debt at any time Helen M. Sheehan (said second party) may demand such payment; and in the event first parties fail to pay said debt immediately upon such demand being made, then the second party shall be entitled to enforce the payment of such debt by action to foreclose this mortgage the same as if first parties had defaulted in the performance of all the other provisions hereof resting upon them to do,

And the said parties of the first part, for the said consideration do hereby expressly waive appraisalment of said real estate, and all benefit of the homestead exemption and stay laws of the state of Oklahoma.

The foregoing conditions being performed, this conveyance to be void; otherwise of full force and virtue.
