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of a servants' house to be used only the servants of the owners of the lot or lots hereby conveyed shall not be considered as a breach of the condition hereof. All subsidiary buildings erected on property herein conveyed shall conform in architecture and construction with the main building. The foregoing conditions and restrictions are hereby made obligatory upon the party of the second part, her heirs and assigns.
