218419 C. J. COMPARED OIL AND GAS LEASE

AGREEMENT, Made and entered into the 17th day of October, 1922 by and between Fannie Daly and  
T. F. Daly, husband and wife of Bristow Oklahoma, hereinafter called lessor (whether one or  
more), and H. O. BLAND of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, hereinafter called lessee:

WITNESSETH: That the said lessor, for and in consideration of One dollars, cash  
in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and of the covenants and agreements  
hereinafter contained on part of lessee to be paid, kept and performed, has granted, demised,  
leased and let and by these presents does grant, demise, lease and let unto the said lessee  
for the sole and only purpose of mining and operating for oil and gas and of laying of pipe  
lines, and of building tanks, powers, stations and structures thereon to produce, save and take  
care of said products, all that certain tract of land situate in the county of Tulsa State of  
Oklahoma described as follows, to-wit:

East Half (E $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of North East Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of  
Section 16, Township 18N., Range 14 E. and containing eighty acres, more or less,  
It is agreed that this lease shall remain in force for a term of One years from this date, and as  
long thereafter as oil or gas or either of them is produced from said land by lessee.

In consideration of the premises the said lessee covenants and agrees:
