INDENTURE, by and between PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY OF OKLAHOMA, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Oklahoma, (hereinafter sometimes referred to as the "Company"), party of the first part, and AKSEL K. BODHOLDT, party of the second part.

WHEREAS, at a meeting of the Board of Directors of the Public Service Company of Oklahoma, held on the 31st day of August, 1922, the following resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS, the Public Service Company of Oklahoma by Indenture dated October 1, 1913, appointed William T. Abbott, as Co-Trustee with the Central Trust Company of Illinois, Trustee under the Company's First and Refunding Mortgage dated June 1, 1913; and

WHEREAS, the said William T. Abbott, Co-Trustee under the Company's said First and Refunding Mortgage dated June 1, 1913, died on May 29, 1922;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That pursuant to the provisions of Section 7 of said Supplemental Indenture, dated October 1, 1913, and the provisions of Article Fifteen of said First and Refunding Mortgage, dated June 1, 1913, the officers of the Company be and they are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to execute and deliver an instrument appointing
