ASSIGNMENT OF OIL AND GAS LEASE.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable considerations to the said Fred A. Stubbs in hand paid by Phillips Petroleum Company, a corporation, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the undersigned does hereby bargain, sell, transfer, assign, set over and convey unto said Phillips Petroleum Company, its successors and assigns, all of his right, title and interest in, to or concerning the above described lease and rights thereunder, insofar as the same covers the above described lands.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Phillips Petroleum Company, its successors and assigns, during the full term of said lease; subject, however, to all terms and conditions contained therein. And for the same consideration, the undersigned, for himself, his heirs or assigns, hereby covenants with the said assignee that he is the lawful owner of the said lease, and all rights thereunder, insofar as it covers the above described lands; and has good right and authority to sell and assign the same; and that the same is free, clear and unincumbered of all liens of whatsoever nature or kind; and that all royalties and rentals due thereunder have been duly paid.
