## WARRANTY DEED RECORD NO. 436

This Indenture, Made this 2nd day of January, A. D., 1922, between  
Robt. E. Adams, and Sara E. Adams, his wife,  
of Tulsa, County, in the State of Oklahoma, party of the first part and  
J. W. Kruisselbrink, party of the second part.

Witnesseth: That in consideration of the sum of One and no/100 DOLLARS,  
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, said party of the first part do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

All of Lot One (1) in Block Four (4) in Edgewood

Place Addition to the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma,

according to the recorded plat thereof.

This deed is made subject to an easement in favor of Lot 2 in Block  
4 of Edgewood Place Addition covering the South 4 feet of Lot 1 above mentioned pro-  
viding for the use thereof of such 4 feet by the owner of said lot 2 for the purpose of egress and ingress to garage for driveway purposes.

To Have and To Hold the Same, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever.

And said parties of the first part for themselves and for their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part that at the delivery of these presents that they are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance in fee simple, of and in all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear and discharged and unincumbered of and from all former and other grants, titles, charges, estates, judgments, taxes and assessments and incumbrances of whatsoever nature and kind, EXCEPT.

A First mortgage in the sum of \$5000.00 in favor of the Home building & Loan Association and special assessments hereafter to mature.

and that they will warrant and forever defend the same unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns against said party of the first part their heirs and assigns, and all and every person or persons whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
