County, in the State of Oklahoma, party of the first part and

Jack Wells

party of the second part.

Witnesseth: That in consideration of the sum of

Three Hundred Fifty (\$350.00) and No/100

DOLLARS,

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, said part of the first part do hereby these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said part of the second part his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot numbered Two Hundred Seventy-six (276) of the Re-subdivision of Lots 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14 & 15, Block One, Rodgers Heights Subdivision Tulsa County, Oklahoma, according to the recorded plat thereof.

It is further covenanted and agreed by the parties hereto that the following covenant shall be a limitation in Warranty deed, to-wit: 1st.-That no residence shall be erected on said premises within one hundred ten (110) feet of front line of lot, which shall cost less than \$2000.

2nd.-That said premises shall never be sold to a negro.

3rd.-That no building shall be erected within 30 ft. of the lot line facing street.

Any violation of the above restrictions will in itself work a forfeiture of this conveyance and the property herein described shall in that event revert back to the party of the first part upon demand.

To Have and To Hold the Same, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever.

And said Chas. P. Yadon and Eva L. Yadon, his wife, their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part of the second part that at the delivery of these presents that they are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance in fee simple, of and in all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear and discharged and unincumbered of and from all former and other grants, titles, charges, estates, judgments, taxes and assessments and incumbrances of whatsoever nature and kind, EXCEPT.
