DOLLARS, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, said part 1st of the first part do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said part 1st of the second part their heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

All of Lot Four (4) in Hamlin Addition to the City of Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, according to the recorded plat thereof, together with all improvements thereon.

Hamel, and Stella May Hamel, his wife, for themselves, their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part 1st of the second part that at the delivery of these presents that they are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and indefensible estate of inheritance in fee simple, of and in all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear and discharged and unincumbered of and from all former and other grants, titles, charges, estates, judgments, taxes and assessments and incumbrances of whatsoever nature and kind, EXCEPT.

Special and general taxes not yet due, and a first mortgage of \$1200.00 to the Farm and Home Savings and Loan Association of Missouri, dated December 20th, 1922.

and that they will warrant and forever defend the same unto the said part 1st of the second part their heirs and assigns against said part 1st of the first part, their heirs and assigns, and all and every person or persons whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
