And said parties of the first part, their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part that at the delivery of these presents that they are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance in fee simple, of and in all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear and discharged and unincumbered of and from all former and other grants, titles, charges, estates, judgments, taxes and assessments and incumbrances of whatsoever nature and kind, EXCEPT.

All coal rights in or under said land herein above described as shown by indenture dated January 2nd, 1920, same being of record in Book 343, page 68 of the records of Tulsa, County, Oklahoma, conveying said coal rights to Charles W. Brewer.
