In The County Court For Wagoner County,

In The State of Oklahoma.

In the matter of the estate of George Simon, deceased. Order Approving Sale of Full Blood Inherited Land.

Now on this 24th day of August, 1908, there coming on to be heard the application of Mandy Simon, Caesar Simon and Sam Simon, for the approval of a Warranty Deed to E. E. Lewis conveying all of their undivided three sixths interest in and to the allotment of George Simon deceased, described as being the SW¹/₄ of Section 11, Township 18 north, range 13 east, Muskogee County, Oklahoma.

And it appearing to the Court that said George Simon died intestate in that portion of the Creek Nation Indian Territory, that is now included in ^{Wagoner} Wagoner County, Oklahoma.

And it further appearing that said Mandy Simon (now Mandy Brown), Caesar Simon and Sam Simon, are full blood Creek Indians and heirs at law of said George Simon, deceased, and that the sale of their respective interests in and to the above described premises have been duly advertised for two successive weeks in the Courta Times and Wagoner Record, published at Courta and Wagoner, Wagoner County, Oklahoma according to the Order of this Court heretofore made and that proof of said publication has been duly filed herein and it further appearing that the consideration being paid for said premises is equal to two thirds of the appraised value thereof.

Now Therefore it is hereby considered, ordered and adjudged by the Court that the Warranty Deed made, executed and delivered by Mandy Brown (nee Simon), Caesar Simon and Sam Simon to E. E. Lewis on August 24th 1908, conveying their undivided three sixths interest in and to the premises above described, be and the same is hereby confirmed and approved. Done in open Court at Wagoner, Wagoner County, Oklahoma.
