Order Confirming Oil and
Gas mining Lease.

Now, on this 10th day of September, 1908,
coming on to be heard the petition of S. R. Lewis,
guardian of the person and estate of Sherman
Pruitt a minor and it appearing to the Court
that he as such guardian on the 10th day of
September, 1908, under the general order of Court
relative to leasing minor lands for oil and gas
mining purposes made executed and delivered
an oil and gas mining lease to the Eagle Oil
Company, a corporation of Bartlesville, Oklahoma
said lease covering the following described lands
belonging to Sherman Pruitt, Minor:

SW 1/4 of NE 1/4 and NW 1/4 of SE 1/4 of section 32, and W 1/2
of SE 1/4 of SW 1/4 and SW 1/4 of NE 1/4 of SW 1/4 of section 21,
all in Township 22 north, Range 13 east, contain-
ing 110 acres, more or less.

And it further appearing to the satisfaction
of the Court that the sum paid for said lease
as a bonus was not disproportionate to the value
of the property sold and that it was fully adequate
and that it further appearing that the lease provides
for 18 royalty of all the oil produced and saved
from the premises, that in case gas is found,
lessor is to receive \$150 per year for each well so
long as gas is sold therefrom of the premises.

It is therefore Ordered, Adjudged and Decreed by the Court that
the lease be and the same is hereby confirmed, approved and
declared valid. Dated this 10th day of September, 1908.
