

Quit Claim Deed.

This Indenture, Made and entered into this 7th. day of September 1908, by and between Edgar M. Ratcliff party of the first part, and Nancy Cooking head, party of the second part.

Witnesseth: That the party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to him duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged has remised, released, and quit-claimed, and by these presents does for himself, his heirs, executors and administrators, remise, release, and forever quit claim unto the said party of the second part and to her heirs and assigns forever all his right, title, interest, estate, claim and demand, both at law and in equity, of, in and to all the following described lands situated in the County of Chulaski and State of Oklahoma to wit: N. 2 of SE 1/4 of 22 1/4 Section 22 in Township 21 and Range 13 East; said land being a part of the Charles allotment of the grantee, a Cherokee full blood, Recd no. 29817.

Do Have and To Hold the Same together with all and singular the hereditaments, and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining to the above described premises forever unto the said Nancy Cookinghead, her heirs and assigns, so that neither he the said, Edgar M. Ratcliff or any person in his name and behalf, shall or will thereafter claim or demand any right or title to the said premises or any part thereof; but then and every one of them shall for these presents be excluded and forever barred.
