

Int. Claim Land:

This Indenture, made this 11th day of June A.D. 1908, between John H. Thomas, Grant Foreman, and Carolyn Foreman, two nys, all of the subject of Oklahoma, parties of the first part, and John S. Bily, of Kansas, Oklahoma, party of the second part; It is covenanted, that for and in consideration of the sum of one (\$100) dollar is conveyed the part of the first part by the party of the second part, with which it is hereby acknowledged, and other valuable considerations, the part of the first part do by these covenants convey and quitclaim unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma to-wit: The east half of the northeast quarter of section 21, township 19 north, range 14 east, and the undivided one half interest of the part of the first part in and to the southeast quarter of section 20, township 19 north, range 14 east.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise in anywise, forever.

This deed is made and executed by the part of the first part to perfect the second title of the first part of the second part, the said part of the first part having, during the early part of the year 1907, executed and delivered to the party of the second part their warranty deed covering the land described above, said deed having been with the last recorded by the same were recorded in the proper recording district.

And S. Carolyn Foreman, wife of the said Grant Foreman a fore named, do hereby relinquish, release and quitclaim all my right and claim to the above land and do not live any part of the premises heretofore described.
