To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the appurtenances and privileges thereto belonging or pertaining, and all the estate, right, title interest and claim whatever of the said party of the first part, either in law or equity, to the only proper use, benefit and behoof of the said parties of the second part, their heirs and assigns forever.
